Urine Pregnancy Result: _____

While pregnancy is the most likely reason for the presence of hCG in urine, other conditions may be associated with detectable hCG, i.e., ectopic pregnancy, molar pregnancy, or patients with trophoblastic and nontrophoblastic disease. Early pregnancy associated with low levels of hCG may not be detected with this kit. If pregnancy is suspected, consider ordering a serum quantitative hCG or re-collect in 48 hours. hCG may remain detectable a few days to several weeks after delivery, abortion, natural termination or hCG injections.
